The herd owner should retain the PINK copy, and the testing veterinarian should retain the YELLOW copy.

In order to be eligible for recertification, all animals must conform to the following categories:

- 1. All animals were included on the preceding annual herd test and have remained on the premises; OR
- 2. Natural additions to the herd too young to test on the preceding certification test (identify as NA on test chart); OR
- 3. Test-eligible purchased additions (identified as **PA** on test charts) that:
 - A. Originated from a Certified Brucellosis Free Herd or a Class Free State do not need to be tested before entering the herd. However, they must be tested within 60 to 120 days after being added in order to qualify for Certified Brucellosis Free status for sale purposes; **OR**
 - B. Originated from a non-certified herd that has passed a negative blood test 30 days prior to entry into the herd and a second negative blood test 60 to 120 days after entry into the herd. These purchased additions to a certified herd do not obtain certified free status until they are included in the yearly (anniversary) test; OR
- 4. Re-tagged animals must be identified as RT on test charts. Note previous tag number if possible.
